Part 2: Extrovert Types

Last week I introduced the introvert types, for me, a more familiar area. Today I will introduce you to the 8 extrovert types. Though they might be more in the foreground, comfortable in large groups, and expressing their feelings, they are not all the same.

Like I said, there are 8 extroverted personality types consisting of, again, 4 letters. Every type begins with the 'E' which stands for 'Extroversion'. Then there is a distinction made between 'Intuition (N)' and 'Sensing (S)', which tells you something about the way you prefer to take in information. 'Thinking (T)' and 'Feeling (F)' tells you something about which way you prefer to make decisions. 'Perceiving (P)' and 'Judging (J)' indicates the way you prefer to live your outer life.

Each personality type can be broken down into an 'Assertive (A)' type and a 'Turbulent (T)' type, which are represented by the last letter of the acronym. Assertive types are calmer and worry less, while turbulent types are more perfectionists and sensitive to how others see them.

ANALYSTS

ENTJ-A / ENTJ-T Commander

If there is one group of people that are born leaders, it is the commanders. Their strengths are being efficient, inspiring, self-confident, strong-willed, and strategic thinkers. However, they tend to be stubborn, intolerant, and impatient. Commanders take the lead in relationships as well and they take their relationships very seriously. They expect a lot from their friendships. For example, they seek friends with whom they can share their passion for meaningful discussions. It might be no surprise, but commanders are most likely to become leaders of an organization or a team.

ENFJ-A / ENFJ-T Protagonist


